

District Youth Council FAQ

What is the District Youth Council?

The council consists of district youth who are committed to ministering to the youth of the district and expanding God's kingdom on Earth. The council is youth led and directed. The youth elect a president, board of officers, have by-laws and conduct business meetings. Youth coordinators are there to guide and advise the youth.

What is the time commitment?

The District Youth meet once a month at one of the district churches. Once every 3 months we meet together with the youth of the other districts (Conference Youth Council) at a church somewhere in the Conference. During the summer for a week at the end of June / beginning of July we gather at Wesley Woods in Dowling, MI for Youth Assembly. If you are able, you may be asked to attend annual conference.

What does the District Youth Council do?

The youth council plans and operates district and conference youth events. They help in raising money for the youth service fund. Some are elected by the youth to be representatives at annual conference, where they have full vote on matters of the church. Some sit on church boards and committees. The youth have fellowship and fun too!

What do we do at Youth Assembly?

This is the big event of the year, held at Wesley Woods. There are things to do such as swimming, basketball, canoeing, and other fun things. We also have some work to do. This is where the youth elect a president and officers at the conference youth level. We hold business meetings to plan the year out for the conference youth.
